During the three days, teachers will hold a number of practical lessons that will take place simultaneously in six classrooms located on the noble floor.

Several workshops will be held in the multipurpose hall by the guest star of the event.

LOCATION

PALAZZO DELLA MERIDIANA (già Palazzo Grimaldi)

The Palace was built between 1541 and 1545, ideally beginning the urban transformation of the city, which was followed by the construction of Strada Nuova (the current Via Garibaldi).

The Palace is located in the historical center of the city, close to the most beautiful Museums and Palaces of Genoa.
